

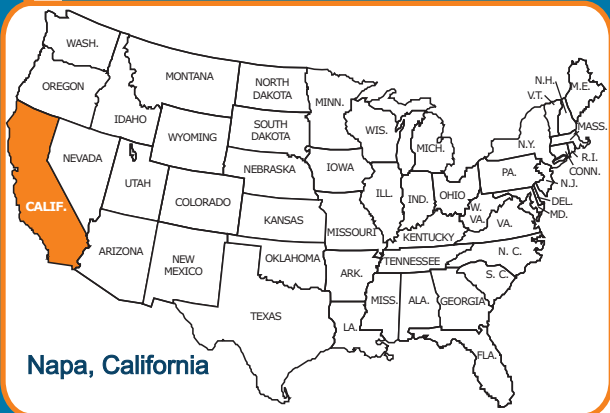


# Private High School Program

## Justin-Siena High School

### About the School

Justin-Siena High School is a co-educational, Catholic day school located in Napa, California. The school is committed to excellence in preparing young men and women of diverse backgrounds to think critically and to be compassionate, responsible, confident persons capable of adapting to an interdependent world community. Justin Siena High School challenges each student to his or her highest potential, and offers a rigorous honors program to meet any student's aspirations. The school enrolls approximately 600 students each year with approximately 23 of these being international students.



### Location

The Justin Siena High School is located on 37 acres of land in Napa, California. Napa is a city of about 60,000 people, located just 55 miles northeast of San Francisco. Napa is part of Napa Valley, an area that is famous across the United States as the beautiful "Wine Country" of California. The nearby city of San Francisco is a wonderful city with professional football and baseball teams, as well as many museums, theatres and an open-air market on the coast. The average temperature in the summer is 82 degrees Fahrenheit, while the average temperature in the winter is 57 degrees.

### Academic Program

Justin Siena High School has a challenging, college preparatory program with a core academic curriculum as well as a diversified variety of electives. Beyond the core academic curriculum, Justin Siena offers a religious studies program that strives to enhance all facets of a student's life. The school has honors programs in English, science, social studies, mathematics and foreign languages as well as Advanced Placement preparation in history, science, foreign languages, computer programming and English. Students interested in attending Justin Siena High School must be proficient in English as ESL is not offered. International students are able to earn diplomas from Justin Siena High School after one year provided all school and state and local requirements are met.



### Facilities

Justin Siena has a 37-acre campus located in Napa, California. Facilities on the Justin Siena campus include classrooms, administrative offices, two gymnasiums, a cafeteria, outdoor athletic fields, including a new all-weather track and field, four computer labs, a performing arts center and a library.
